BE IT KNOWN, That we, the subscribers, do hereby associate ourselves as a body politic and corporate, pursuant to the statute laws of the State of Connecticut regulating the formation and organization of corporations without capital stock, and the following are our articles of association:-

Article 1. The name of said corporation shall be the Connecticut Music Educators Association, Incorporated.

Article 2. That the nature of the business to be transacted, and the purposes to be promoted or carried out, by said corporation, are as follows:

(a) Its purpose shall be threefold; educational, cooperative and social; educational in placing before its members the most advanced pedagogical thought relating to their own and kindred professions; cooperative, in bettering general teaching conditions, in extending the sphere of influence to its members through the prestige of the organization and in securing a wider recognition of the educational value of music; social, in promoting good fellowship and encouragement among its members.

(b) It shall be the policy of this corporation to work in close cooperation with all other educational organizations having a similar purpose.

Article 3. The said corporation is located in the Town of Hartford and its principal office at No. 22 Seyms Street, and the agent upon whom process against it may be served is Joseph H. Soifer.
